FIRE TEAM INFORMATION:

Grades:	The WYC "Fire" Team is a competitive team for athletes in the 6 th through 8 th grade. Some 5 th graders may be invited to join the Fire team, but that will be by coach's selection only.
Season:	Fire's season will run from September 12 th , 2019 through February 23 rd , 2020. Participants will be required to be available that entire time with the only exceptions being Thanksgiving and Winter Break.
Practices:	Fire will practice on Thursdays from September 12 th through October 31 st from 6:00 – 8:00 pm at Westview. The week of November 4 th , practices will switch to two days per week. They will most likely be Mondays and Thursdays at Westview from 6:00 – 8:00 pm. This is tentative though as our winter practice space schedule at Westview is still being finalized.
Choreography:	Choreography will be Sunday, September 29 th @ Styleshock. Choreography is mandatory so please mark your calendars so your athlete is available.
Competitions:	The WYC Comp Teams will primarily compete at the same local competitions as the Westview High School Varsity and JV teams. Here is the tentative competition schedule for the 2019-2020 Fire Team. Uniform:	The WYC Comp Team will wear a uniform provided by Westview Youth Cheer. In addition, part of their competition cheer fee will cover their competition bow & bodysuit.
Tumbling:	The Fire team will participate in tumbling classes at ODT. These will be set up and paid for separately through the WYC Board.

ICE TEAM INFORMATION:

Grades:	The WYC "Ice" Team is a competitive team for athletes in the 2 nd through 5 th grade.
Season:	Ice's season will run from November 4 th , 2019 through February 23 rd , 2020. Participants will be required to be available that entire time with the only exceptions being Thanksgiving and Winter Break.
Practices:	Ice will practice two days per week. They will most likely be Mondays and Thursdays at Westview from 5:30 – 7:30 pm. This is tentative though as our winter practice space schedule at Westview is still being finalized.
Choreography:	Choreography will be done during regular practice times for the Ice team.
Competitions:	The WYC Comp Teams will primarily compete at the same local competitions as the Westview High School Varsity and JV teams. Uniform:	The WYC Comp Team will wear a uniform provided by Westview Youth Cheer. In addition, part of their competition cheer fee will cover their competition bow & bodysuit.
Tumbling:	The Ice team is not required to take tumbling, but if any are interested, tumbling classes at ODT will be set up and paid for separately through the WYC Board

REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

- Registration: Visit www.westviewcheerleading.com to register. Click on the "Youth Cheer" Tab. Registration information and the link to the registration form are available there.
- Deadline: Fire Registration will be open through September 1st, 2019.
Ice Registration will be open through October 20th, 2019.
- Openings: 8 – 25 members per team.
- Eligibility: In order to be eligible to be a part of a WYC Comp Team, athletes will need to meet the following minimum requirements:
Be a member of the 2019 Westview Youth Cheer Sideline Program
Be in 2nd – 8th grade
Be available for all practices and competitions.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION:

- Expenses: The expense per cheerleader will depend on how many total kids we have in the program. Therefore, the final amount won't be known until Ice registration closes on October 20th, 2019.
- Fire: The estimated cost to be on a WYC Fire Comp Team is between \$490.00 (30 comp members) and \$675.00 (20 comp members).
- Ice: The estimated cost to be on a WYC Ice Comp Team is between \$415.00 (30 comp members) and \$560.00 (20 comp members).
- Includes: This will cover the following expenses:

Choreography & Music
- Tumbling: Fire will be expected to participate in a tumbling class at ODT once per week. This will be set up through the WYC Board and be a separate/additional expense.
- Payments: You will have a \$100.00 deposit due at your first practice (September 12th for Fire & November 4th for Ice). That payment will be payable to "Westview Cheerleading". Your remaining balance will be due in December after WYC has completed their fundraising which will help you to offset your expenses. Please note that no scholarships are available. Payment plans will be available if needed.

TEAM RULES & EXPECTATIONS:

- Attendance: All practices and competitions are mandatory. Illness and family emergencies (ie: funerals, etc.) that are approved by the coaches are the only excused absences. Dental, doctor, hair and other appointments must be made outside of practice time. Vacations should be scheduled around the cheer schedule as well. Cheerleading is a large time commitment and families need to be prepared to make that commitment along with their cheerleaders.
- Conduct: As a WYC Comp Team member, you will represent yourself, your team, and your coaches at all times. Your actions need to reflect that honor.
- Dress Code: Athletes will be expected to wear the designated practice outfits at all practices and the assigned apparel to competitions.
- Insurance: Athletes are required to have medical insurance. Insurance information must be provided on the registration form.
